I will be meeting with my sub-committee members to review and update, with a lense on loneliness, a Christian family life resource kit created by other members many years ago. This will be shared with all of you as an enclosure with my next directive in mid-October after our fall Ontario provincial council meeting October 3-5. Please keep all of us in your prayers at that time so our deliberations are guided by the Holy Spirit.
